Grading Remarks

*Failing grades underlined on report cards. Formula for figuring grade when NOT on a 10, 20 or 100 point scale: figure subject grade average for the year, then DIVIDE the average by the SUR or MAXIMUM (sometimes it is 30, 50, 200, 300 etc.). This will give you the grade equivalent using the HUNDRED point scale. MOYENNE = GPA (10 Point Grade Scale)

Country Notes

In the traditional system, primary education lasts for six years, in the reform system, it is replaced by fundamental education which lasts for nine years. Fundamental education is composed of three cycles of three years each. The first two cycles constitute primary (basic) education, and the third one corresponds to the first cycle of the traditional secondary level. At present, the educational reform has not yet been generalized and the traditional system still prevails. Based on the French system, secondary education lasts for seven years and is divided into two cycles (three and four years). The Baccalauréat 1e partie is a certificate awarded after succeeding in the state examination at the end of the third year of the second cycle. The Baccalauréat 2e partie, taken at the end of the fourth year, is a state diploma that marks the end of the secondary level. The new secondary system that should follow the nine years of fundamental education has not yet been introduced.
